Invitation to join the first-ever global initiative on how people perceive the circular economy

Dear colleagues,

[Imagine Circularity](#) – the first-ever global initiative on perceptions of circularity – seeks to understand how different stakeholders see and imagine the circular economy. The aim is to engage one million participants from around the world to produce a representative sample of their views and understandings.

The survey will officially launch on 19 April 2021 and end on 15 January 2022. A global report and a series of customized reports on a large number and broad variety of audiences will be published in March 2022. Our open science and open data principles allow for ground-breaking academic publications on the perception of circularity.

This initiative by [REVOLVE Circular](#) and the [Copernicus Institute of Sustainable Development](#) invites you to join the global survey effort. Your organization is an important stakeholder in the global circular economy community and we would be honored if you were to become an official partner.

While any individual can participate in the survey at any point in time after its launch in April 2021, only organizations can become partners. Local, regional or national authorities, non-profit organizations, universities, intergovernmental organizations, businesses of all sizes, media organizations, industry associations, think tanks, foundations, and other organizations are eligible.
